Dear Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2027,

Congratulations! Your student is about to embark on their senior year of high school and will be featured in the 2027 Clovis East High School yearbook with a color portrait in the senior section. Larson Brothers Photography is pleased to take your student's photo and offer affordable studio fees during the summer. We have been fortunate to have Larson Brothers on campus during the school year for any makeup photos needed, but these sessions are not guaranteed. We encourage all seniors to complete their portraits over summer. If studio costs are a concern, please contact Yearbook Advisor, Emily Stites. These are formal portraits and students must be dressed appropriately and adhere to the standards set below. For your student's portrait to be included in the yearbook, they must adhere to these formal attire standards. Any photo that reflects a violation of these standards will result in your student's picture being excluded from the Clovis East High School yearbook.

- Blouses/Dresses must have sleeves.
- Necklines must not be too low, tops/blouses may not have cutouts, and tops may not be off the shoulder.
- Sheer or see-through tops may not be worn.
- Shirts should be collared, and a tie must be worn.
- Suits may be worn with a collared shirt and tie.
- A CEHS Letterman Jacket may be worn with a collared shirt and tie or a blouse.
- Clothing, jewelry, and personal items shall be free of writing, pictures, or any other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane, or sexually suggestive; shall not bear drug, alcohol, or tobacco company advertising, promotions, or likenesses; shall not promote violence, illegal activity, or relate to gang affiliation or activity; and shall not advocate discrimination or harassment of race, religion, or sexual orientation.
- Hair must be clean and neatly groomed.
- Hair, beard, or mustache styles which disrupt the learning environment are not acceptable, e.g., unusual designs, colors, symbols, messages, mohawks, Faux-Hawks, or unusual razor cuts in the hair or eyebrows.
- Tattoos, permanent or temporary, must be covered.
- Piercing jewelry is acceptable in the ears only. Piercing jewelry that is intended to alter the natural shape of the ear is prohibited. Other body piercing jewelry (e.g., that for piercings in the eyebrows, nose, lips, or tongue) is not acceptable.
